



## Frequently Asked Questions

### IS FARMHOUSE'S ATMOSPHERE SIMILAR TO THE STEREOTYPED FRATERNITY?

No. It is unfortunate that media has falsely stereotyped fraternities. At FarmHouse, we hold true to our motto, "Builder of Men," and we do so with our four aspects: Intellectual, Physical, Social/Moral, and Spiritual. These aspects cultivate an environment in which our members build friendships that will last a lifetime.

### HOW DO YOU HANDLE ALCOHOL IN YOUR FRATERNITY?

At FarmHouse, we believe that the consumption of alcohol is a personal choice and should not be influenced by one's living environment. We are a dry fraternity which means alcohol is not allowed in the chapter house or at chapter functions. FarmHouse men are expected to be responsible and exhibit good moral character at all times.

### WHAT DOES K-STATE'S NEW FIRST YEAR HOUSING POLICY MEAN FOR YOU?

Starting in the fall of 2022, all first-year students are required to live on campus for their first two semesters at K-State. Certain exemptions are available and living in a fraternity has been categorized as an exemption. Refer to K-State's Housing and Dining Services website for more details.

### WHAT ABOUT NEW MEMBER EDUCATION AND HAZING?

FarmHouse strictly abides to strict anti-hazing policies and new members will never undergo hazing. Every fall semester we have a ten-week new member education program to help new members learn about the operations of the house which includes community service projects, leadership retreats, and responsibilities as an active member.

### WHAT KIND OF IMPACT WOULD THIS FRATERNITY HAVE ON ACADEMICS?

At FarmHouse, we take pride in our grades, and consistently rank among the top five fraternities at K-State by average GPA. All members of the fraternity are required to maintain a 2.7 GPA and we have an elected Scholarship Chairman to help keep members accountable for their grades. Furthermore, one wing of our chapter house serves as a 24/7 library environment available for academic use.

### DOES FARMHOUSE FRATERNITY REQUIRE A LOT OF TIME?

It is important to realize that FarmHouse Fraternity is more than just a place to live. It is an interactive environment in which friendships are built that will last a member's lifetime. Also, members are required to do their equal part in caring for the chapter house and encouraged to be active and involved in the fraternity. FarmHouse Fraternity offers many leadership positions within the house and on campus.

### HOW DOES MY SON JOIN FARMHOUSE FRATERNITY?

Now is the best time to contact the Recruitment Chairs and learn more about when we will have formal recruitment weekends. Most recruitment is in the winter and spring, when we will host four weekends which potential new members can visit the house and meet the men of our fraternity although we encourage your son to come to the chapter house anytime he may be in Manhattan. Additionally, we would encourage those interested in our fraternity to attend as many weekends as possible to get an adequate feel for the house and the active members.
